



- **Trogg's Hollow** is a family-owned and run farm doing biointensive urban farming located in Elgin, IL. We have always been passionate about growing vegetables, and in 2009 we expanded our personal growing space to start producing enough for other families. Our goal is to grow good food naturally and to live and farm as sustainably as possible.
We are excited to offer a wide variety of vegetables and herbs, some of which you won't see at your local grocery store. We grow for members of our **CSA** and **local farmers markets**. Our growing season goes from early Spring to late Fall, so it is a fun challenge to provide a nice selection of produce.
- A **CSA** is a farm which sells shares of produce to members. These shares are containers of vegetables or other products from the farm. Consumers become members by purchasing a share before the season begins, and are rewarded with a box of seasonal produce each week throughout the growing season.
- At **Trogg's Hollow** we put no chemicals on our plants other than what nature provides. We need to be able to let our kids go out and pick something and eat it on the spot without worrying about what is on it. We also reclaim and compost as much organic material as we can to help rebuild the soil and we do water when necessary.
- The **Trogg's Hollow 2012 CSA Program** goes from mid-June for **18 weeks** through October with an extra bonus week if the season has been good. We are hoping to supply around 30+ shares this year. We offer **two share sizes** with **multiple payment options**. Shares can be paid for all at once or stretched over 2 or 4 separate payments.
 - Our **full shares** will be a weekly 1/2 bushel and half shares will be a bi-weekly 1/2 bushel. Full shares are set up to be enough for a family of 4 for a week and start at \$650.00.
 - **Half shares** are the same size but would need to be stretched over two weeks and these start at \$350.00.We have several locations for shares to be picked-up. We will create a drop-off site anywhere within reason, as long as we have a willing host with an acceptable location, and at least 5 whole shares each week (any combo of full and half shares) going to that location. Other drop-off sites will be determined once we have a better idea of where members are located.
 - Shares can be picked-up in **Elgin at either the home farm or the Elgin Harvest market**.
 - We also have a drop-off site in **Roselle, IL**.
 - We are currently organizing a drop-off site in the **Wheaton area**.
 - Current interest is also in **Sycamore/Dekalb** and **Wicker Park**.
- Trogg's Hollow is currently accepting applications for our 2012 CSA Program. We can also set up an informational presentation for a group of interested parties.
